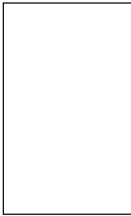

### Celebrating St. Joan of Arc

St. Joan of Arc was born on January 6, 1412 in France to very religious parents. From an early age it is believed that Joan heard the voices of St. Michael, St. Catherine, and St. Margaret. The three saints gave Joan a mission.

When Joan was sixteen the voices became strong and told her to begin the mission. The first part of the mission was for Joan to save France. After a bit of persuasion, Joan convinced a French official that she should have a leadership role in the army.

Joan had a very positive effect on the men she was leading. She had them spiritually prepare for battle by going to confession. She led them into battle to save France. The battle was long, but they were victorious.

The second part of the mission was hard, but eventually the prince of France became King Charles VII. After the prince became king Joan was warned by the voices that she would not live much longer and she must finish her mission.

While trying to complete her last mission, Joan was captured and hurt. She was forced to sign a document saying she didn't hear voices, but she said the document was false. Joan said she was on a mission from God and because of this, she was put to death in 1431.

Her bravery and devotion to God continues to be admired by Christians nearly 600 years later. St. Joan of Arc is the patron saint of soldiers and France. We celebrate her on May 30.

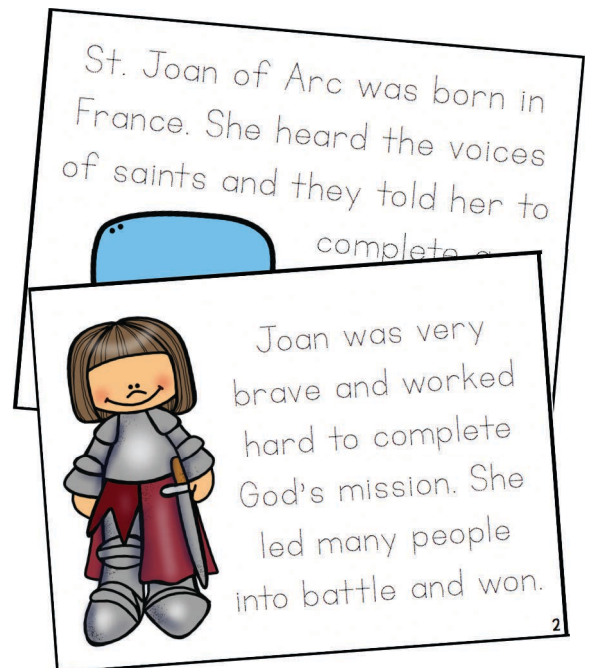
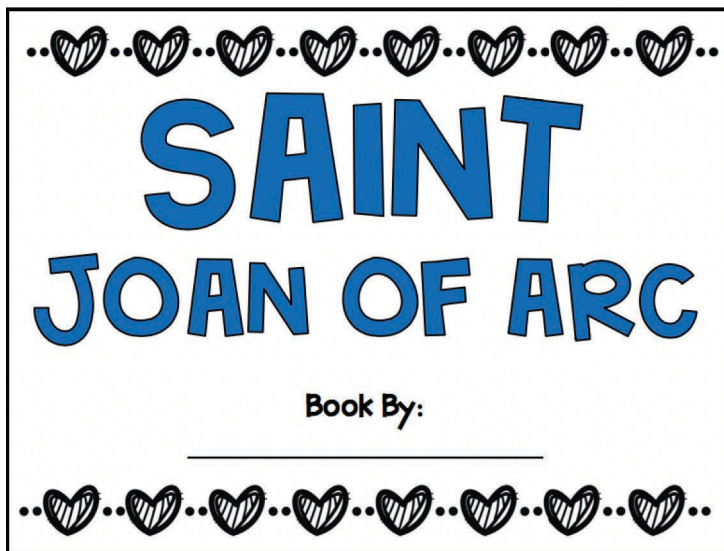
This is the perfect resource for celebrating St. Joan of Arc in the primary grades. In this resource you will find 7 activities:
